LINC and Local Progressive Groups Ride Blue Wave On Long Island “Rally for Democracy”

Huntington, NY: On January 3rd, the first day of the new session of Congress, five Long Island Indivisible Groups will host “Rally for Democracy” at Congressman Thomas Suozzi’s Huntington District Office. This gathering of local activists including Action Together Long Island (ATLI), Dedicated to Democracy, Indivisible Glen Cove, Long Island Network for Change (LINC) and Show Up Long Island (SULI) will celebrate the 2018 Democratic Blue Wave election.

“Rally for Democracy” is part of Indivisible’s National Day of Action, “Whose House? Our House!” in support of the democracy reform bill that Democrats will introduce as their number one legislative priority (H.R.1). Setting the agenda for the new term, the bill focuses on Voter Empowerment and Access, Eliminating Big Money in Politics, and Fighting Corruption at all levels of government, including The White House.

“Rally for Democracy” is an expression of our anticipation for the new Congressional Democratic agenda,” explains LINC’s Lynn Kaufman. Speeches from group organizers, New Year’s Resolutions and a Proclamation presentation, a special Blue Wave Cake, and members performing an actual Blue Wave are included in the day’s events.
